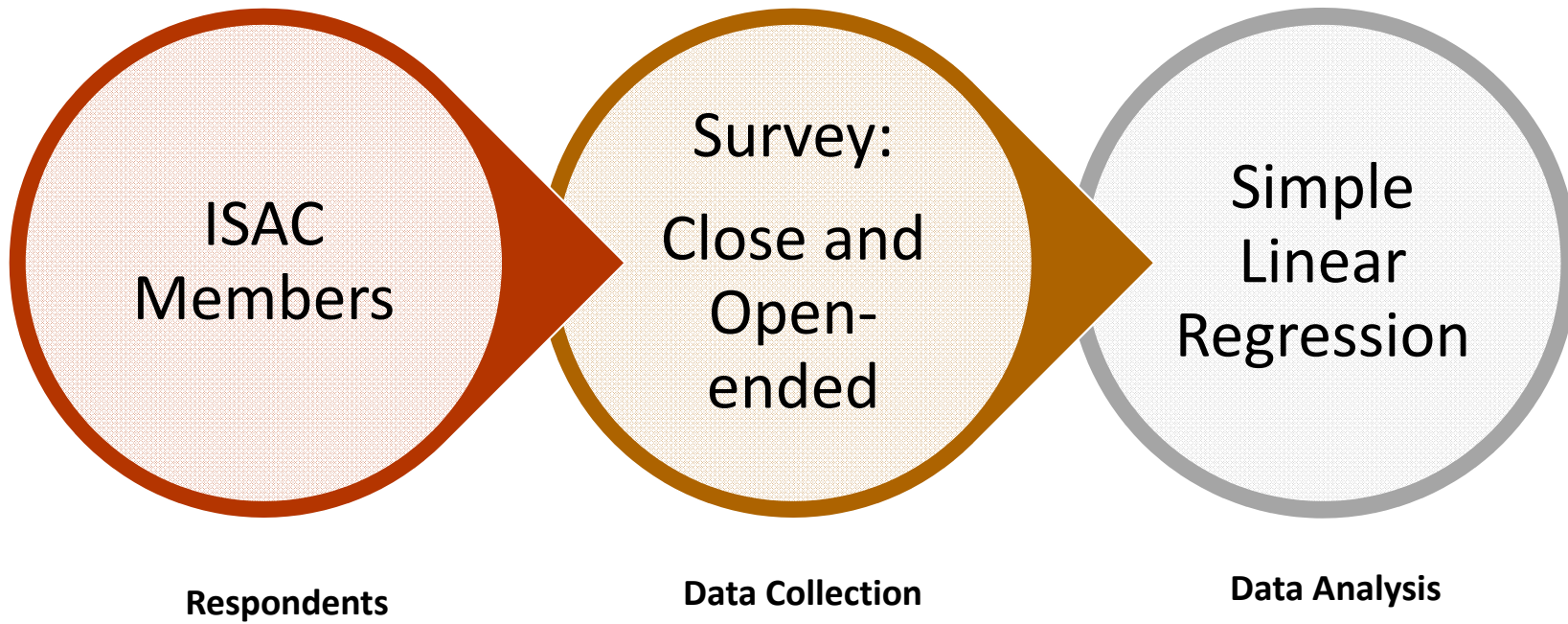
What internal and external factors influence the effectiveness of ISAC?



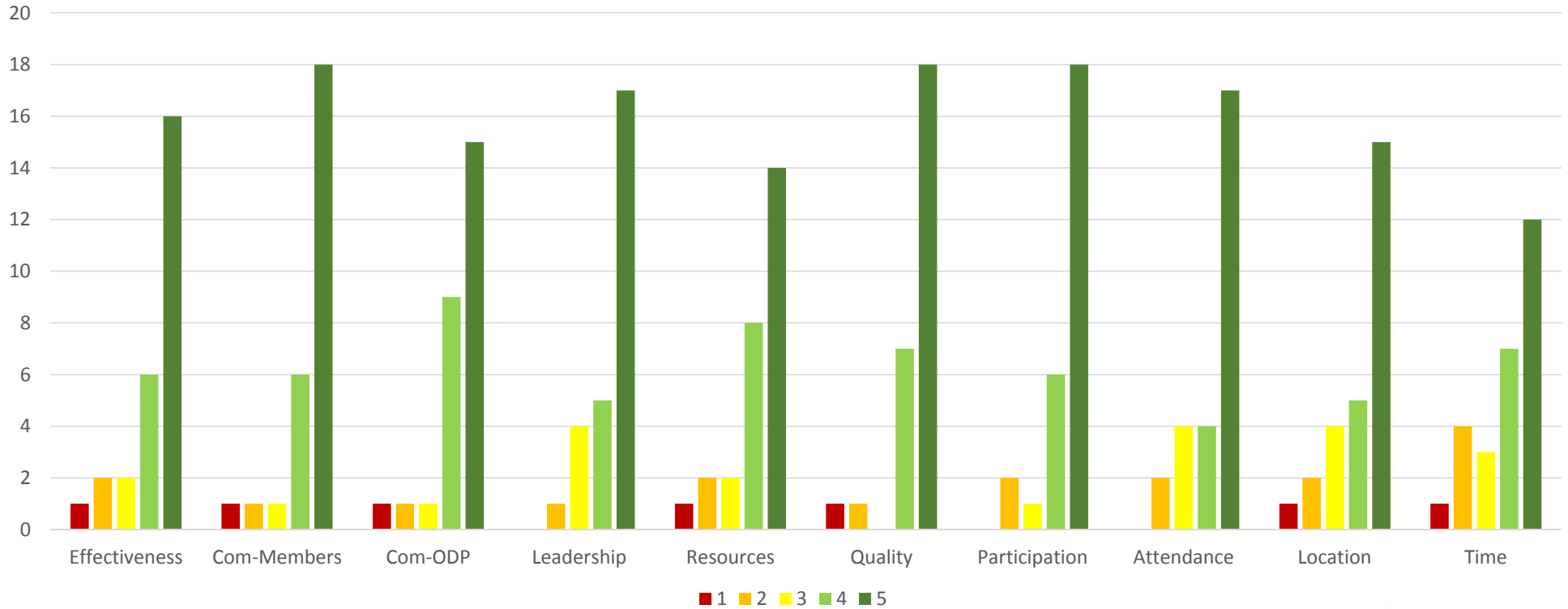

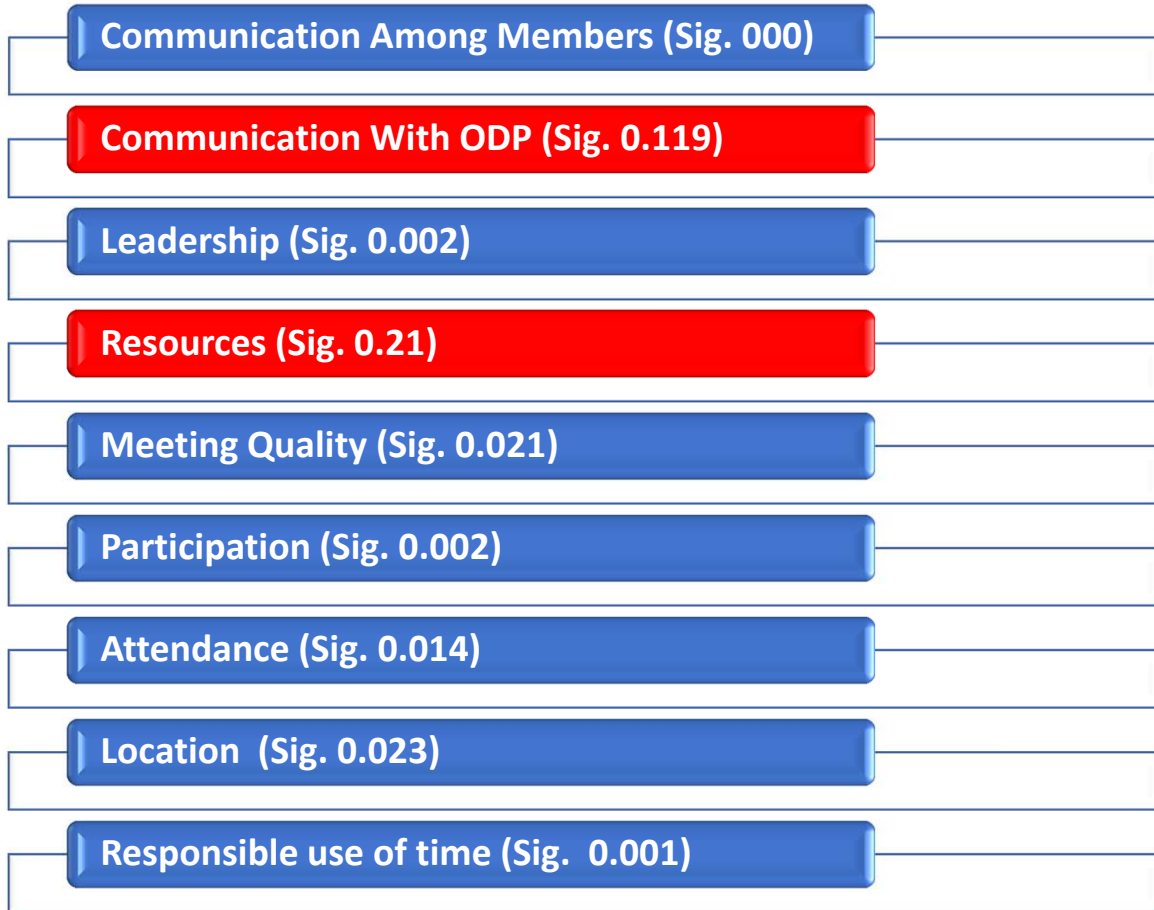

Recommendations

Continue to expand the reach of the ISAC sub committee

Produce meeting minutes

Host meetings in regions of the state that show low participation rates

Require organizational stakeholders to host localized public meetings that will be vocalized at ISAC meetings
