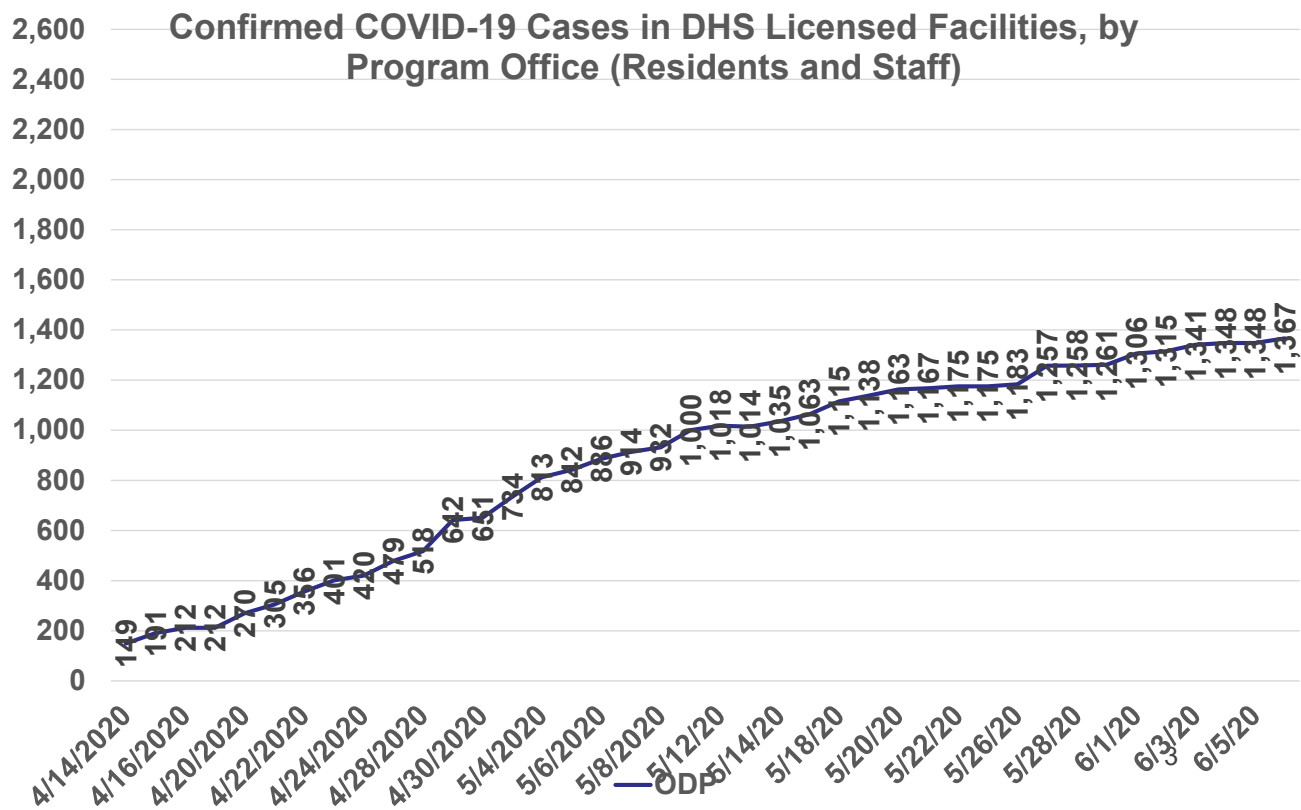

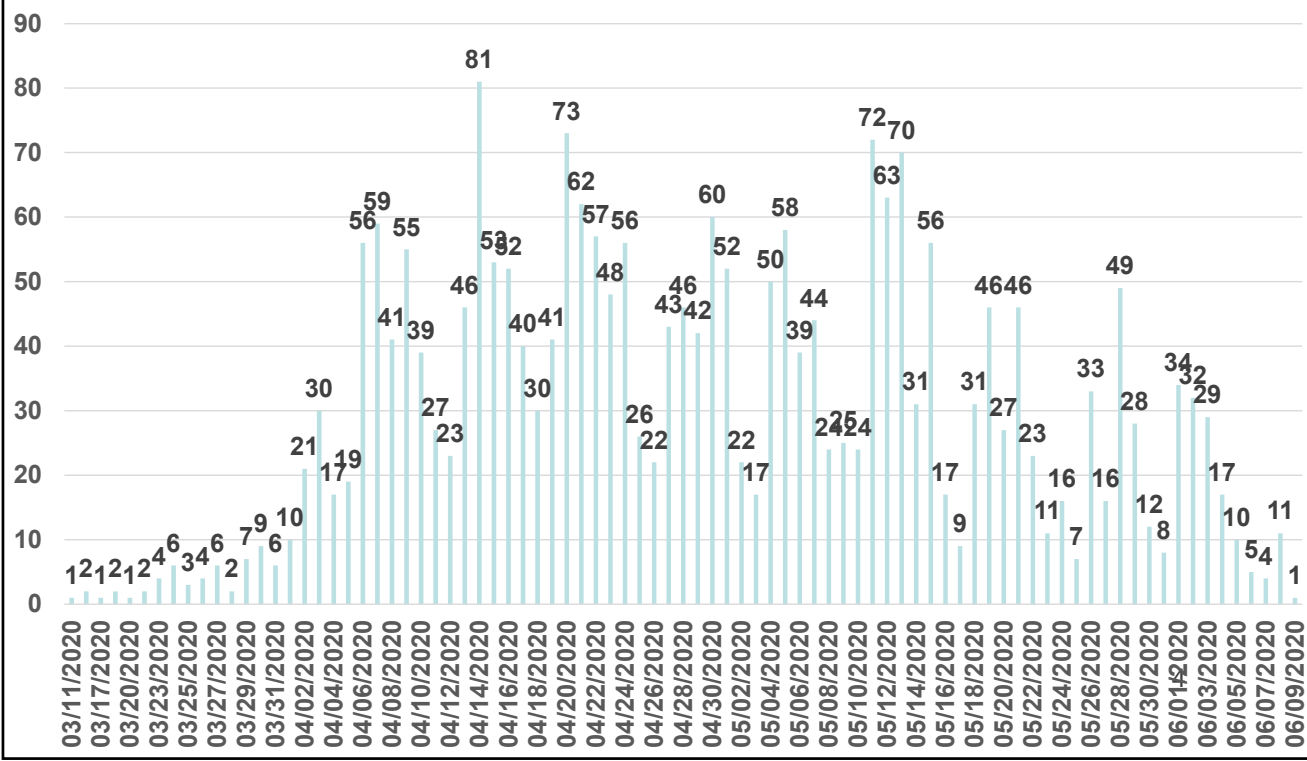

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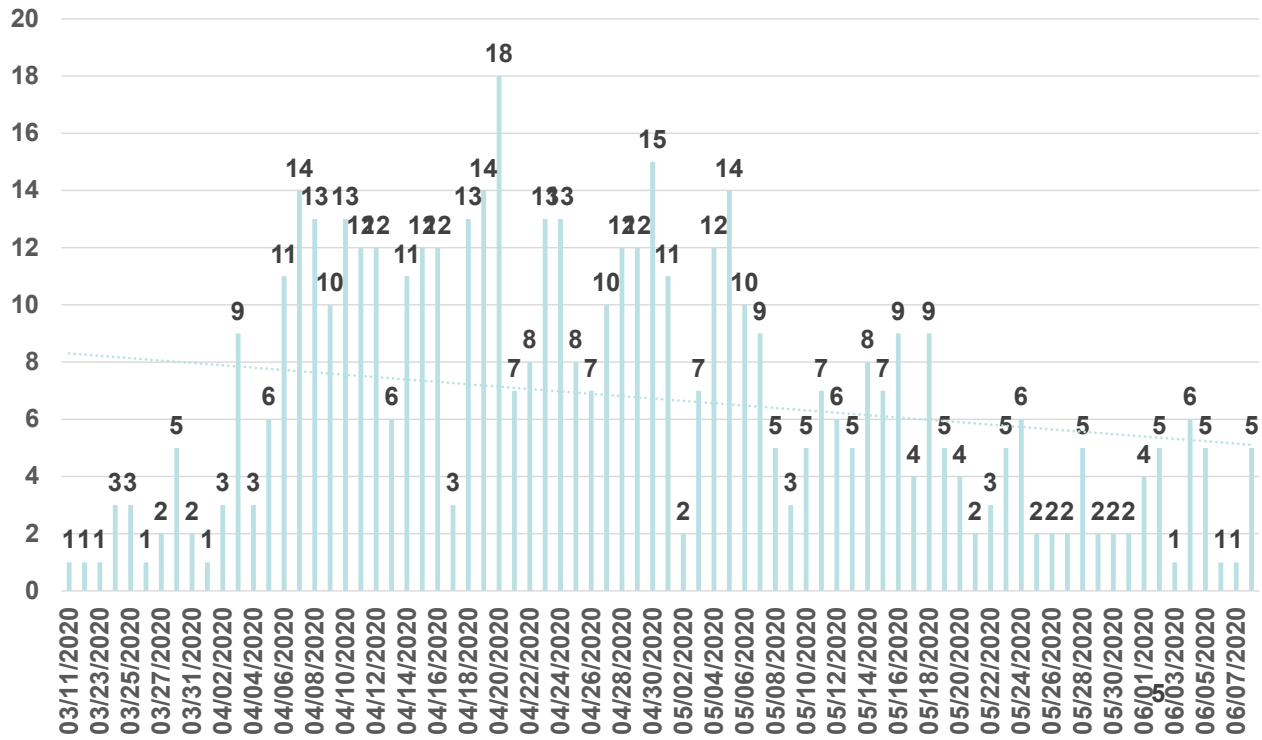


"Suspected/Confirmed" COVID Indicator R 6/9/2020

P/FDS and Community Living Caps

- *ODP Announcement 20-069*
- Appendix K allows cap exceptions for COVID-19 related expenses. It will be necessary to bring FY 21-22 ISP's back within the approved waiver caps.
- With re-engagement in yellow and green phase, service types may need to be different than pre-pandemic.
- CPS facility units may be re-allocated among CPS Facility, CPS Community, In-Home and Community Supports, Companion and/or Respite services as long as the total number of units does not exceed the number of units authorized before the COVID-19 pandemic.

Requirements for individuals to receive annual physical examinations and staff to receive biennial physical examinations are suspended. ODP Announcement 20-032 suspended the requirement to include "the application of person-centered practices, community integration, individual choice and assisting individuals to develop and maintain relationships" as part of the initial orientation and annual training requirements for provider staff. ODP Announcement 20-033 suspended the requirement to provide minimum numbers of hours of annual staff training. ODP Announcement 20-034 established a provisional process for obtaining Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) criminal history record checks in recognition of the fact that many FBI clearance sites necessary for completion of such checks were closed in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
