


## **Employment**

- Federal Department of Labor proposed rule making eliminating 14c – public comment through January 17, 2025
- The department proposes to discontinue the issuance of new certificates and establish a three-year phaseout period for employers with existing certificates once a final rule becomes effective.

# Number and Percent of Individuals ages 18-64 Enrolled with ODP that have CIE




#### Individuals Enrolled with ODP with CIE

# **Performance-Based Contracting**

- Residential: Adjustments and additional activities based on August tier determinations
  - Scoring adjustments for Incident Management Fidelity Measures
  - Revising data submission tool to address common submission errors
  - Requesting documentation submission up front for follow-up from hospitalizations for providers who do not meet measure
  - Provide additional incident management training to cover timeliness, finalization, and incident fidelity process protocol
- Supports Coordination
  - Feedback from ISAC and STG for draft performance measures
  - Rate work

## **AAW Interest List**

- Previously no requirement for individuals on interest list to have level of care determinations for eligibility.
- 1,123 on AAW interest list (9/2024).
- ODP systematically working through list to ensure people waiting are eligible for AAW.
- Ineligible individuals will be removed from interest list.
- 562 individuals received letter instructing them to contact County/AE for eligibility determination.
- Follow-up letter sent 30 days later (9/2024)
- April 2025- letters will be sent to second half of interest list, plus anyone with change of address from the first outreach.



# **Multi-Year Growth Strategy**

- 1,893 individuals enrolled in CLW or CW since Feb 2024
- AE Forum 12/3/24
- Protocol release
- Readiness reviews begin in January with all AEs rolled in by 12/31/25
- Quarterly submissions for waiver capacity adjustments allowable for approved AEs beginning in April
- AE Operating Agreement is being updated to include additional/changed responsibilities
